It is our pleasure to announce the **first Course in Dental Sleep Medicine**, organised by the Swiss Society for Sleep Research, Sleep Medicine and Chronobiology (SSSSC), in the framework of the Annual Congress and in response to the urgent request of our dental colleagues.

The course lasts 2 half days, it is organised by the Scientific Committee of our Society and will start as a pre-congress course on Wednesday, August 21, 2024, the day before the opening of the Annual Congress of Sleep Medicine.

The course aims at Swiss dentists who wish to acquire specific knowledge in the management of dental therapy for sleep disorders, in particular obstructive sleep apnea in adults. Experts in the field will discuss the diagnosis and treatment of snoring and obstructive sleep apnea, providing an essential foundation for dentists wishing to acquire specific skills in the management of mandibular advancement devices.

The course will take place at Hochschulzentrum VonRoll in Berne and will be conducted in English.

Approximately 8,000 patients with OSA are referred to sleep centres each year, where they receive a multidisciplinary approach and a wide range of therapies, which is only possible thanks to the fruitful collaboration between the various medical disciplines.


